AIM

Throughout this two-day course, you will learn the thiroidectomy approach of TOETVA with tips & tricks, indications and management of possible complications.

Endocrine surgery is continuously evolving and new approaches have been presented in order to perform a safe thyroidectomy with the best cosmetic result.

TOETVA approaches the thyroid and central neck compartment bilaterally through a natural orifice, following the shortest way, and leaves no visible scar behind.

However, as a new approach, TOETVA brings new complications related to the port of entry that we must aware.

Although early results are promising, an appropriate patient selection and self-criticism are mandatory in order to make of TOETVA a standard procedure in endocrine surgery.

Here we present you a course based on theoretical lectures, live surgery and a "hands-on" on cadaver-lab.
